US Citizens

- Open the file labeled "Form NV-205"
- print it out,
- fill it in (**) with the requested information (yellow highlighted areas) and
- fax it to the attention of Larry Boing at the following fax # - 630-252-7577.

You will receive confirmation of the receipt of the form by our office.

The "Form NV-205" **MUST** be received by our office by **no later than November 6, 2009(***)**. If this form is not submitted to us by this date we cannot guarantee approval / authorization for you to join the tour.

Non-US Citizens

- Open the file labeled "Form UFV&A Long Format IAP-66"
- print it out,
- **fill in (**) just page 1 of the form** with the requested information (yellow highlighted areas) and
- then fax it to the attention of Larry Boing at the following fax # - 001-630-252-7577.

You will receive confirmation of the receipt of the form by our office.

The "Form UFV&A Long Format IAP-66" **MUST** be received by our office by **no later than September 17, 2009(***)**. If this form is not submitted to us by this date we cannot guarantee approval / authorization for you to join the tour.

(*) Tour access to facilities/sites to be toured even as a part of this TC by the TC participants is solely at the discretion of the operating organization at which the tour is being offered. We cannot and do not guarantee access to any site/facility for this tour - that access authorization is based solely upon the site or facility access authority and their requirements and conditions for access.
