**Nevada Test Site (NTS)
Prohibited Items
(as of April 24, 2008)**

The following items/personnel are ***prohibited*** within the boundaries of the Nevada Test Site:

- **BLUETOOTH “ENABLED” DEVICES** (including laptops and wireless headsets for cellular phones – must be left in one of the lockboxes at the NTS Badge Office)
- **NON-DRIVING PERSONNEL** (team drivers acceptable)
- **PETS**
- **CHEMICAL IRRITANTS** (including mace and pepper spray in excess of two [2] fluid ounces)
- **AMMUNITION, EXPLOSIVES & INCENDIARY DEVICES** (road flares are acceptable)
- **WEAPONS** (including firearms, bows, knives with blades in excess of three inches in length, pellet or stun guns, etc. or any instrument or material likely to produce substantial injury to persons or damage to persons or property)
- **BINOCULARS/OPTICAL INSTRUMENTS**
- **CAMERAS/CAMCORDERS** (including cellular phones with camera capabilities – must be left in one of the lockboxes at the NTS Badge Office)
- **RECORDING DEVICES** (including any audio and/or visual recording device such as a camcorder)
- **RADIO FREQUENCY TRANSMITTING EQUIPMENT** (not allowed in buildings)
- **PRIVATELY-OWNED LAPTOP COMPUTERS** with built-in cameras and/or bluetooth capability (otherwise, authorized) – no computers are allowed to be connected to any government resources
- **NON-PRESCRIPTION CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES**
- **OPEN CONTAINERS OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**
- **ANY OTHER ITEMS PROHIBITED BY LAW**

NOTE: All vehicles are subject to search. All truck compartments and sleeper cabs will be searched.
